

Plan Ahead - Traffic and parking can be difficult and hectic

### Be on time or earlier

### **Drop-off & Pick Up: Walkers**

TK, Kindergarten and First Grade: Parents can walk students to their classrooms and pick up directly from their class

Parents cue up in front of school by kindergarten area; when gate is opened, parents can walk in to their class

Due to Safety Guidelines: Parents are not to linger and are not allowed on the playground past Portable 1


Students in Grades 2-5: Independently enter and exit campus through the large blue gate (adjacent to Acorn Park)

\*\*Please do not pick up from Acorn Park –there is NO school supervision there!





TK, Kinder and First Grade: Parents cue up in front of school by kindergarten area; when gate is opened, parents can walk in

### Drop-Off by Car (AKA Car Line)

Please follow parking lot guidelines

### Kinder and First

Please wait until you are sure your child can independently exit your car and walk to class (or ensure an older sibling/friend can assist)

## Car Line Pick Up

- Students cue up behind the large blue gate until called and then wait on the grassy area
- We use a call ahead procedure:
  - Please have a sign with the child's name/grade clearly displayed at pick up
  - Please keep it displayed until your child is safely in the car

## Parking Lot

- Be patient
- Be courteous; you are modeling for your child(ren)
- Allow enough time; before 7:35 is best
- Lot is closed from 1:40-2:05 –only cars with handicapped placard can enter
- If going uphill on Sanborn
  - Use bus entry if going up Sanborn
  - Second entry is for staff (Parking permit)
  - At dismissal, you may cue up on Sanborn
- If going downhill, make a left into parking lot
  - After school pick up –do not cue up before 2:05 –you will be cited by OCSD

## Chromebook 1:1 Program:

- CUSD will provide 1:1 Chromebook device in grades TK – 12<sup>th</sup>.
