SUGGESTED CLASSROOM SUPPLIES FOR FIRST GRADE

Listed below are supplies that we suggest students bring to class this year. This suggested list has been compiled based on needs identified to support of the delivery of the first grade curriculum.

Suggested Items:

Please have your first grader bring ALL items to class with them on the FIRST day of school. Please place all supplies in a bag labeled with your child's name (do not label individual items, please).

All Students:

- 1 Backpack NO ROLLING BACKPACKS due to safety and space issues
- 1 **SPACE MAKER** plastic pencil box (8' x 5" x 2"); no zippers
- 1 pair **FISKARS** scissors (sharp; child-sized)
- 1 dozen **SHARPENED** pencils
- 1 Magic Rub Eraser
- 3-24 count boxes of *CRAYOLA* crayons
- 2 package skinny black **EXPO** markers fine tip (black color only)
- 5 small size **ELMER'S** Glue Sticks
- I box of Kleenex
- 1 box of **ZIPLOC** bags (sandwich size) Boys bring
- I container of baby wipes (unscented) Girls bring

Teacher Wish List:

- 1 package of **AVERY** sheet protectors (clear and standard weight)
- 1 package white **AVERY LABELS** address labels (1 x 2 5/8") and/or name labels (2 1/3 x 3 3/8")
- 1 ream of White Card Stock (8 ½" x 11" size)
