SUGGESTED CLASSROOM SUPPLIES FOR THIRD GRADE

Listed below are supplies that we suggest students bring to class this year. This suggested list has been compiled based on needs identified to support of the delivery of the first grade curriculum.

Suggested Items:

Please have your third grader bring ALL items to class with them on the FIRST day of school. Please place all supplies in a bag labeled with your child's name (do not label individual items, please).

Suggested Items

- 1 Small Pencil Box 8X5 (**Everything must fit and already be organized in your pencil box**)
 - Colored pencils- box of 12 only or Crayons (Box of 24)
 - 2 Highlighters
 - 1 Pair of scissors
 - 3 Glue sticks (not liquid)
 - 4 Dozen pencils (Sharpened please- Ticonderoga Preferred)
 - 1 Small pencil sharpener with container to catch pencil shavings
 - 1 Box Black fine tip Expo Markers
 - 2 Paper Mate or Pentel Magic Rub White Erasers

- Books/Workbooks/Misc.
 - 2 Spiral Notebooks (Wide Ruled)
 - 2 Pocket Folders
 - Headphones or Earbuds
 - 2 Independent Reading Books
 - 1 Clean Used Sock or Dry Erase Eraser
 - 1 inch & centimeter ruler (clear or wooden)
 - Extra Face Mask (to keep in backpack)
 - Reusable Water Bottle (Bring to school daily)

Suggested Classroom Items

- **2 Pocket Folders**
- **Graph Paper**
- 1 box of tissues
- 2 Bottle of Clorox Wipes
- 1 Hand Sanitizer
- 1 Box Gallon Sized Ziplock Bags
- ***Please have your child bring their device and power cord (ie: Chromebook, iPad, laptop) to school everyday.**
