SUGGESTED CLASSROOM SUPPLIES FOR FIFTH GRADE

Listed below are supplies that we suggest students bring to class this year. This suggested list has been compiled based on needs identified to support of the delivery of the fifth grade curriculum.

Individual Items:

- 1 Zippered Pencil Pouch – NO plastic pencil boxes
- 4 Ink Pens - any color for correcting
- 1 – 4 pack multi-colored highlighters
- 4 spiral bound wide ruled notebooks
- 1 dozen #2 Sharpened (DIXON TICONDEROGA) Pencils or Mechanical Pencils (with extra lead)
- 1 Box (24 pack) Crayola Colored Pencils (sharpened)
- 1 Box of Crayola Crayons 24 count
- 1 Set Crayola Colored Markers – NOT scented
- 1 Pair of student size scissors (Fiskars preferred)
- 1 Pencil Sharpener (handheld with attached collection container)
- 1 package glue sticks
- 1 package Expo markers (Chisel tip only), non scented
- 2 Black sharpies (fine and medium tip)
- 3 – 2 pocket folders (without prongs)

Classroom Items:

- 2 reams of White Copy Paper
- 1 ream each of colored copy paper (blue, yellow, pink, green)
- 2 Boxes of Kleenex
- 2 package of lemon Clorox wipes
- 1 8 oz. bottle hand sanitizer (Purel preferred)
